REGISTRATION

FIRST TIME dual credit students must follow the steps outlined below or on the SPC Dual Credit webpage: www.southplainscollege.edu/admission-aid/apply/dualcredit/AdmissionRequirements.php

1. **SPC ADMISSIONS APPLICATION:** located online at the website above. Create an account to begin.
It is vital that you complete steps 1-4 way in advance to the payment deadline to give yourself enough time to get it all done. SPC deadlines are not flexible
2. **DUAL CREDIT ENROLLMENT APPROVAL:** Submit your approval request to your counselor by completing all questions on this google form: <https://forms.gle/sjy2w3cKHpP3YcfF8>
3. **TRANSCRIPT:** Request a copy of your high school transcript from the LHS registrar, Vanessa Maldonado, in the administration office. Ask her to submit it electronically to SPC via TRex.
4. **TSI SCORES:** Provide to SPC proof of passing TSI scores or proof of meeting exemptions via ACT, SAT, PSAT/NMSQT or STAAR scores. See TSI Assessment Quick Reference in the next section for more information.
5. **REGISTRATION & PAYMENT:** Once all steps are completed, log in to your "MySPC" account to register for course and submit payment to SPC by their deadline. Cost is \$50.00 per credit hour.

RETURNING dual credit students with South Plains College must:

1. **DUAL CREDIT ENROLLMENT APPROVAL:** Submit your approval request to your counselor by completing all questions on this google form: <https://forms.gle/sjy2w3cKHpP3YcfF8>
2. **REGISTRATION & PAYMENT:** Log in to "MySPC" account to register for course and submit payment by deadline. Cost is \$50.00 per credit hour.

TSI Quick Reference for Dual Credit 2022-2023

Texas Success Initiative Assessment (TSIA) Scores for Compliance:

TSIA 2.0 is the newer version of the TSI:

Math 950 or 910 + 6 Diagnostic

ELAR 945 +5 Essay or 910 + 5 Essay + 5 Diagnostic

- **Pre-Assessment Activity (PAA)** must be completed PRIOR to taking the TSIA2. The link for the PAA can be found on the testing page for SPC or on the counselor page for Lubbock High School. Print the completion certificate sent via email and take it to the testing location on the day you take the TSIA2.
- **Test through LISD:** Register for TSIA2 with the LHS testing coordinator, Sharesa Brady in room 2107 or call 219-1731. TSI 2.0 cost is \$10.00 (cash or check) for all parts and \$5.00 for re-test on each part. Upcoming LHS test dates: May 14 or May 21
- **Test through SPC:** Register for TSIA 2.0 online through SPC at <http://www.southplainscollege.edu/admission-aid/advising/testing/TSIassessmentschedule.php> Testing fee is \$33 for all parts and \$23.00 for one 1 part. **Subject to change*

TSIA Exemptions:

1. **SAT** – 530 on mathematics and/or 480 evidenced based reading and writing (EBRW)

2. **ACT** - Composite score of 23 with a 19 on the Math and 19 on English

***STAAR, SAT and ACT scores are valid for 5 years from date of test.**

3. Students who have satisfactorily completed college-level coursework (as determined by the receiving institution); at SPC, this is a grade of C or better in a previous dual credit course.

4. **PSAT/NMSQT**—Administered on or after October 15, 2015 for Dual Credit Eligibility; (PSAT 8/9 cannot be used):

460 Evidenced Based Reading & Writing (EBRW) and 510 Mathematics

5. **STAAR EOC** - *(These scores can only be used for students' junior year enrollment in Dual Credit classes.)*

STAAR EOC Scores (Juniors)-- Does NOT meet TSI for their senior year. Algebra I 4000 + Passing Grade on Algebra II High School Class

STAAR EOC Scores (Juniors)--Does NOT meet TSI for their senior year. English II 4000
