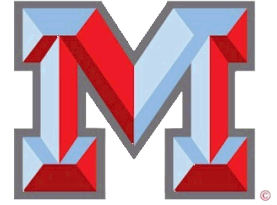

The Lubbock Independent School District covers 85.5 square miles and serves over 26,000 students.

Monterey High School is a four-year comprehensive public high school (9-12) serving approximately 2,200 students. Monterey is one of five high schools in the Lubbock Independent School District. Monterey offers a rigorous college-preparatory academic program that yields a large percentage of high school graduates advancing to post-secondary education each year. Varied course offerings and an eight period per day schedule allow students to meet individual needs and pursue multiple interests. All English, Mathematics, Science and Social Studies classes are offered on two levels: Advanced (Honors/Pre-AP/AP) and On Level.

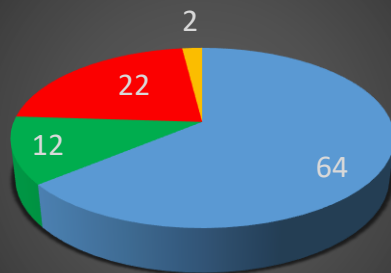

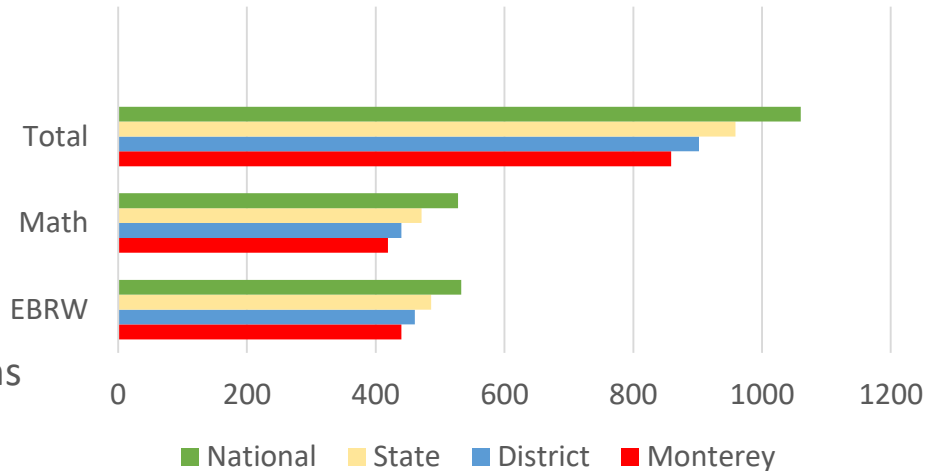

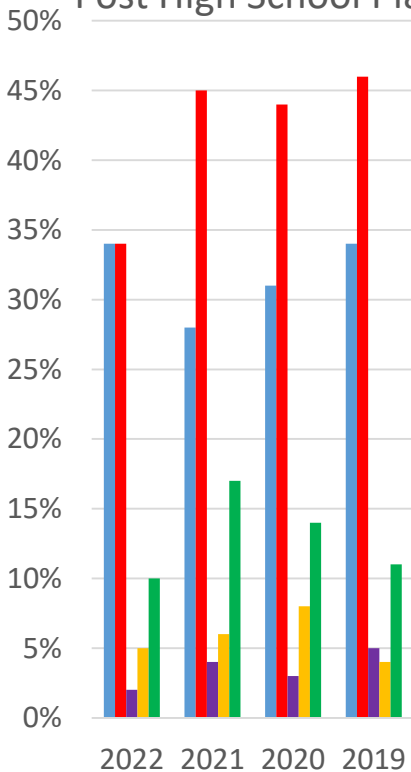


AVERAGE SAT Scores, 2021-22
