

Open to eligible Lubbock County High School graduating seniors:

1. The **Don & Sybil Harrington Scholarship** is for those going into the Math, Science, or Engineering fields. The award is for \$5,000.00 a year for 4 years and is highly competitive. (*DEADLINE: March 15*)
2. The **Lubbock Manufacturing Scholarship** is for those going into metal trades or industrial technologies. (*DEADLINE: July 1*)
3. The **George Scott Jr.** award is for an African American student from a Lubbock County high school who will be attending Texas Tech. (*DEADLINE: May 15*)
4. **Lubbock Art Association Scholarship** is for those who plan on continuing their education in an arts related field. (*DEADLINE: March 13*)
5. **Association of Texas Leaders for Education Scholarship** is for a Texas resident graduating senior who will be attending a Texas school to pursue a secondary education. (*DEADLINE: March 15*)
6. **Fallen Heroes Scholarship** is to assist with educational expenses of dependent survivors of service men and women and first responders who have died on active duty since September 11, 2001. (*DEADLINE: Open*)
7. ****NEW** Honey Bear Scholar** was launched in 2019 to honor the many contributions of Mary E. Massengill who retired from Lubbock ISD at the age of 85 after a 44-year career as a Kindergarten Teaching Assistant. Student must have attended Honey Elementary to be eligible to apply. (*DEADLINE: April 15*)

Specific to Coronado High School:

1. **Danny Gunn Memorial Scholarship (Texas Area 1 FFA Schools)**

This scholarship was established by Melinda Gunn in memory of Danny Gunn, a dedicated agriculture teacher and FFA advisor. Danny Gunn was proud of his students' accomplishments and throughout his life impacted innumerable lives throughout his teaching career. Eligible students must be a graduating senior at a Texas Area 1 FFA High School with a GPA of 3.5 or higher, member of FFA in High School, and attending Texas Tech University or Texas A&M University.

Deadline to apply: April 30

2. **Girl Scouts Gold Award Scholarship**

This scholarship was established by Frances Winn for a graduating senior who has achieved the level of Gold Award with the Girl Scouts organization. Preference will be given to Lubbock Co. High School seniors then open to graduating seniors from Texas-Oklahoma Plains schools.

Deadline to apply: May 1

3. **Mark & Becky Lanier Raider/Mustang Scholarship**

This scholarship was established for Graduating Coronado HS Sr. who attended CHS for 4 years and Mackenzie Middle School for 3 years; 3.0 or higher GPA; Involved in Extracurricular activities and community service; Financial need will be considered; Plans to attend Jr. College or 4 year University.

Deadline: April 1

4. **Mr. & Miss Mr. & Miss Coronado School Scholarship**

This fund was established by Mr. Robert Snell to benefit outstanding graduating seniors of Coronado High School who have been selected as Mr. & Miss Coronado High School.
