# GPA RANK UPDATE

## 2027 Seniors

GPA rank changes are effective beginning in the 2022-2023 school year and apply to current seventh-grade students.

### Important Changes

- ✔ Cumulative GPA determines rank. 16 courses (32 semesters) in the subjects of English, Math, Science, and Social Studies have the potential to carry weight. The top four courses in each core subject plus unweighted credit for all other courses equals your GPA.
- ✔ Other courses outside of the 16 do not have any weight even if they are AP, IB, dual credit, etc.

### PREPARING STUDENTS FOR SUCCESS

**Lubbock ISD is full of choice!**

To achieve a high GPA, students tend to only take weighted classes, causing them to miss out on other courses they may be interested in.

The class of 2027 will be able to take any elective they want, without lowering their GPA.
