

DRESS CODE

- Students shall be dressed and groomed in a manner that is clean and neat and that will not be a health or safety hazard to themselves or others.
- The District prohibits pictures, symbols, emblems, jewelry, or writings on your body, clothing and/or personal belongings that:
 - Are lewd, offensive, vulgar, or obscene
 - Advertise or depict tobacco products, alcoholic beverages, drugs, or any other substance as prohibited by the District
 - Refer to satanic, cult, or gang activities, including but not limited to: Slashed eyebrows, colored shoestrings, web belts, jewelry
 - Exhibit tattoos that depict gang symbols/letters, profanity, or inappropriate pictures
 - Disrupt classroom instruction
- No clothing that has been modified in a revealing manner.
- Oversized clothing shall not be worn.
- Pants must be worn at the natural waistline.
- Tattoos on a student must be covered
- See-through/chiffon blouses may not be worn without a shirt under it or a piece of clothing over it.
- The neck opening on any type of shirt or blouse may not exceed the equivalent of the second button below the collar of a dress shirt or blouse.
- Underwear-type shirts such as tank tops or muscle shirts shall not be worn.
- Bicycle shorts shall not be worn.

DRESS CODE

- Footwear shall be a part of regular attire. House shoes and roller shoes are not acceptable footwear for school.
- Appropriate undergarments shall be worn at all times.
- No sleepwear or pajamas
- Pants/shorts must be at fingertip length when hand placed vertically on leg.
- No holes in shorts/pants above fingertip length
- Leggings or tights are allowed if the shirt completely covers the buttocks area and is the same length in the front as it is in the back.
- Head wear is not allowed (caps, hats, hoodies, etc.)
- The hair shall be clean, well-groomed, and shall not cover the eyes and the hairstyle shall not create a classroom distraction or make a reference to or possibly be interpreted as gang related.
- Extreme hairstyles are not permitted.
- Sideburns shall be kept trimmed so as not to form a beard and shall not be extreme in fullness.
- Mustaches shall be acceptable if neatly trimmed and beards are not acceptable.
- Students may not wear large facial studs, facial rings, or tongue bars, and body piercing must not be visible, nor may it be extreme or disruptive.
- Spacer earrings, gauges, and plugs are prohibited.

DRESS CODE

- If administration determines that a student's grooming violates the dress code, then...
 - student shall be given an opportunity to correct the problem at school.
 - If not corrected, the student shall be assigned to in-school suspension for the remainder of the day or until the problem is corrected.
- Repeated offenses may result in more serious disciplinary action. Appropriate discipline procedures shall be followed in all cases.
- Extra-curricular – The sponsor, coach or other person in charge of an extracurricular activity may develop and enforce standards of behavior that are higher than the district-developed standard.
 - Membership or participation in an extracurricular activity may be based on adherence to those standards.
 - Students who violate those standards may be removed or excluded from the activity for a period determined by the principal and/or sponsor and may be subject to other disciplinary action.
