The Byron Martin Advanced Technology Center (ATC) is located at 34th and Ave. Q. The center was established to provide advanced Career & Technical Education (CTE) programs for 10th-12th grade students from all Lubbock ISD (LISD) campuses.

Students may request information about enrolling in ATC courses from their school counselor or they may contact the [ATC](#) directly to request a tour. When enrolled in the LISD CTE program, students continue to belong to their home campus and take at least two (2) consecutive classes or one double-blocked course at a time, so they are at the ATC campus for two (2) periods every day. LISD provides transportation to and from the ATC with buses available at every high school throughout the day, or students may provide their own transportation.
