Through a systemic effort, students in the Coronado feeder system have the opportunity to engage in 21<sup>st</sup> century experiences through the Infinity Project in middle school and through a system of engineering preparatory courses at Coronado High School from Engineer Your World, the Infinity Project, and EPICS. Students are able to be part of our STEM program by following a coherent set of courses in either the engineering or robotics pathway during their high school career. **In 2014, Coronado High School was the first LISD campus to be **DESIGNATED a STEM Academy by the Texas Education Agency.** There are just over 130 campuses in Texas with this designation. These Academies serve as demonstration schools and learning labs, which develop innovative methods to improve science and math instruction. The cornerstone of STEM Academy learning is student engagement and exposure to innovation and design in STEM-focused instruction and learning that models real-world contexts. T-STEM Academies serve as demonstration sites to inform math and science teaching and learning statewide. The T-STEM initiative aims to closely align high school curriculum with admission requirements of competitive colleges and the STEM qualifications for 21st century jobs.**

**Coronado High School is the only LISD campus to offer engineering courses through the Engineer Your World program.** Our mission is to prepare students to be college ready, career ready, and life ready. Through our STEM program, we have partnerships with the Texas Tech University, South Plains College, Southern Methodist University, the University of Texas, Purdue University, and the National Science Foundation to support our students in this mission.
