



Dear Cavazos Parents:

After holding parent meetings, researching the impact of student dress on school climate, and polling our faculty, Cavazos Middle School is proud to implement standardized dress for students. Students will be expected to come to school the first day of classes in standardized dress.

For the 2020-2021 school year, the standardized dress code for students will include the following:

Tops

- Polo-type, solid color, collared shirts – Navy, Gray, Black.
- Undershirts must also be white or black. **(No Red)**
- No decorative stripes, designs, patches on shirts.
- **No brand logos**

Bottoms

- Pants, joggers, capris, shorts, or skirts – in khaki color.
- Shorts/Skirts must be approaching the knee- length should not be shorter than 2" above the knee. There should be no designs, colors, rips/holes, logos, or patches on shorts or skirts.
- Pants **must** be fitted at the waist and stride. No oversized or baggy pants. Students will not be allowed to "sag".
- No sweatpants, jeans, jeggings, leggings or "stretch" pants.

Accessories

- Belts are optional. **(No Red)**
- Solid black, navy, or gray pullovers/ jackets/ hoodies are allowed. Hoods must remain off the head during the school day. **No Brand Logos**
- Girls may wear black or white tights under their skirts in cool weather. **(No Red)**
- Hats of any kind will not be permitted.
- Shoes and socks are required to be worn. **(Shoes and socks must not have ANY Red)**
- Gloves and scarves are not permitted in the classroom.
- Facial masks will be required to cover nose and mouth at all times. (Masks may not have Red and may not be bandanas)

"Free Dress" Days may be awarded throughout the year for designated students and/or student groups. These days will be by INVITATION ONLY and will be limited in number. No red will be allowed anywhere at any time, including "free dress" day. **(No Red)**
