ACADEMIC INTEGRITY: You will be working in groups some of the time for classwork and graded assignments. This work is expected to be a collaborative effort and an exchange of ideas and work is part of these assignments. It is expected that all students perform their *own* work on tests, quizzes and individual projects. **A student found to have engaged in academic dishonesty shall be subject to grade penalties on assignments or tests. Academic dishonesty includes cheating or copying the work of another student, plagiarism and unauthorized communication between students on any formal assessment (formative and summative). The determination that a student has engaged in academic dishonesty shall be based on the judgment of the classroom teacher or another supervising professional employee, taking into consideration written materials, observation or information from students.**

Remember, most universities will send you **home** for cheating.

AP PREP SESSIONS: There will be 3 AP prep sessions offered on Saturdays throughout the year. Tentative dates are February 18th, March 25th, and April 22nd from 9:00am-1:00pm at Coronado High Schools. Finalization of these dates will be announced in class ASAP.

CALCULATORS: We will use the calculator on class work, homework and tests. I have a classroom set of TI-Nspire calculators for student use in class. If a calculator is needed for homework and there is not one available at home, the school library has TI-Nspire calculators available for checking out and the calculators are also available for use whenever I am in the classroom (i.e. before school, etc.).

CHROMEBOOKS: You are required to bring your chromebook everyday.

BINDER & NOTES: You are required to bring your binder everyday.

GRADING:

Assessments- 100%

Summative Assessments: Chapter Tests, Quizzes, Projects, Essays, Free Response, etc.

Formative Assessments: Daily grades, etc.

Formative Assessments: Formative Assessments will be assigned almost daily. Work is due by 4:30 PM on Friday (unless otherwise stated).

If work is not turned in on time, there will be a 5 point deduction per day. 8 days from the original due date *the assignment will not be accepted and the student will receive a zero (0) for that assignment with no corrections.*

If a student has been absent, then it is his or her responsibility to check the hanging folder to get make-up work. **Any work due on the day absent, will be due upon return to class.**

Assignments will be averaged for a weekly assessment grade, meaning any missing assignments will lower your overall assessment grade.

Summative Assessments - QUIZZES/TESTS: There will be two or three teacher created tests each nine weeks. In addition to teacher tests, students will have regular quizzes and daily quizzes to make sure they are retaining all the information. ALL work must be shown or no credit will be given.

Reteach and Reassess is available on all assessments with grades lower than 80% in order to bring the grade up to a possible 80. BEFORE you are allowed to retest, you must have completed all formative assessments.

Realize that retaking your tests not only will improve your grade but will help you realize your mistakes before the next test.

If an absence is on the day of a quiz or test, the student MUST schedule a time before or after school to make it up (I will not bug you to take care of this...if you choose not to take the test/quiz, your grade will be a zero).

FOOD & DRINK: Water is allowed in the classroom. However, other food and drink may not be brought into the classroom.

PASSES: There will be no passes during the first 15 minutes of class. There are no passes at all during 5th period.

CELL PHONES: All classrooms will follow the district wide cell phone policy. Students are not allowed to have cell phones or any electronic device (other than a Chromebook) visible in the classroom for any reason.

DISCIPLINE CARDS: This class will use the standard Estacado discipline card system. The first infraction will result in a yellow warning card. The second infraction will result in a red card requiring the student to stop the behavior. The third infraction will result in a green card and referral. Automatic green cards will be given for **fighting or other acts of violence, illegal behavior, extreme profanity or vulgarity, and leaving the classroom without permission.**
