Expectations

Course overview:

- This course is designed to take you from an introductory level to college ready in the field of Integrated Physics and Chemistry. We will begin the year with Chemistry then Physics with a lot of fun concepts in-between. We will use real life experiments and study concepts that you can observe outside of school. Students, please note that my conference period is 5th period. I will be available for tutorials during this period or any time after school if communicated. Also, no Hall passes will be given before the first 15 minutes of class.

Classroom Expectations
