

PSAT, PSAT 8/9 - 2022

The **Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test** (PSAT/NMSQT) is a program co-sponsored by College Board and the National Merit Scholarship Corporation. It is a standardized test that provides first-hand practice for the SAT.

Ninth-grade students will have the opportunity to take the **PSAT 8/9**, the 9th-grade level PSAT. Tightly aligned with the SAT, PSAT/NMSQT, it establishes a baseline for college and career readiness as students enter high school.

BOTH, the PSAT/NMSQT (ALL 10th, some 11th) AND PSAT 8/9 (ALL 9th) will be given at CHS on Wednesday, October 12, 2022. Students will arrive at their assigned room by 9:00 am.

Due to numbers, calculators will be provided to 10th and 11th graders only. Ninth grades students may bring a calculator if they wish. ALL questions can be answered without a calculator. NO cell phones may be used.

LISD is once again providing this **test free of charge to all sophomores and freshmen in the district** as well as all junior students who scored 165+ on the PSAT as a sophomore.

Cost for **juniors** wanting to take the PSAT/NMSQT test is \$20, due **September 19 - 30, 2022** to Mrs. Loafman in the main office.

****ADDITIONAL NOTE**** Students who wish to have accommodations on any College Board exam **MUST** contact Mr. Sheppard (219-1162), special services counselor by email or phone for further instructions on this matter. School accommodations are **NOT** automatically given on all College Board Exams. PSAT, PSAT 8/9 are **NOT required exams for high school graduation or college entrance.**

****HOMESCHOOLED STUDENTS****

The PSAT will occur on LISD HS campuses on October 12th. LISD attendance zone homeschooled students who wish to take the PSAT exam on an LISD campus, must register no later than September 9, 2022, with the PSAT testing coordinator within your attendance area.
