

SCHOOL DAY SAT 2021

The Basics

All LISD juniors will take the SAT with Essay **FREE of charge** on **Wednesday, March 3, 2021 during the school day**. No registration is necessary. Testing will begin at 8:15am. Masks are required to be worn at all times during the test. This is NOT a late start day for ANY CHS students.

Students need to bring two number two pencils and a calculator if they wish to use one on the exam. See www.sat.org for a complete list of acceptable calculators.

Lunch will not be served until after the exam, so students are encouraged to bring a small snack.

****VIRTUAL STUDENTS**** - Those juniors that are virtual **MUST** come to school on this day to test **IF** they wish to take advantage of this opportunity. College Board does **NOT** offer a remote option for SAT testing. The SAT is not a required test for receiving a high school diploma.

The Benefits

- Testing on a school day does not interfere with weekend work/family obligations.
- More students are able to show up and take the SAT when it is offered at their school.
- Stress is lower because students test in a familiar location with staff they know.
- All students who take the SAT can send their scores to as many as four colleges free.

Services for Students with Disabilities (SSD)

Some students with documented disabilities are eligible to test with accommodations on the SAT, however, students **must be approved to do so by College Board**. Free Practice

Khan Academy - At Khan Academy, students can access thousands of questions approved by the College Board, take eight official SAT practice tests, and create personalized study plans based on their results. <https://collegereadiness.collegeboard.org/sat/practice/khan-academy>

Daily Practice App - Students can make practice part of their routine - any place, any time. Answer a question a day on the Daily Practice of the New SAT app, and get immediate feedback.

Paper/Pencil Practice - Taking an official SAT practice test is a great way for students to simulate test day. Students can score their own practice test and learn from their mistakes. Official SAT practice tests are available online.
