Grades and Credits: Students have the opportunity to earn 8 credits each year (4 fall/4 spring). Credits are earned by receiving a semester grade of 70 or higher AND meeting attendance requirements of 90% according to state law.

Credit Deficiencies: Failed courses that are needed to meet graduation requirements must be retaken for credit.

Credit Denial: Credit that is removed as a result of not meeting the state attendance law.

Transcripts: The official high school student record includes courses, grades, test scores, rank, and GPA.

Individual 9th grade student meetings will be held during the spring semester to discuss 4 year plans and student transcripts.
