



First Day of School Information

The first day of school is **Wednesday, August 15th**. The following information will help alleviate some of those “first day jitters” and inform you of some changes for this year:

- **School begins at 7:35 A.M. and students need to be with their teachers in their assigned classroom areas no later than the 7:45 A.M. bell.** Students arriving before 7:35 A.M. will need to go to the cafeteria to wait for the 7:35 A.M. bell.
- We will continue to offer “*Breakfast in the Classroom*” this year. The breakfast carts will be in the area from 7:35-7:45 each morning. The cost of a school lunch is \$1.90.
- **School will dismiss at 3:25.** Please make sure your child understands who will pick him/her up and where. A map of Dismissal zones is also enclosed for your information. After school care is provided on our campus by Y-CARE. Please contact the YWCA for more information on this program at 792-2723.
- Look for a **packet of information** to come home with your child on the first day of school. Please take the time to read through this important information and complete any forms to send back to school.
- In regards to the student dress code please go to the districts website at www.lubbockisd.org, click on the “Parent” tab, and go down to the “Student Code of Conduct”, and look under “Dress Code”. A hard copy of the dress code will be available in the front office.
