

Compulsory Attendance Law

Compulsory attendance laws require students between the ages of 6 and 18 to attend school unless the student is otherwise legally exempted or excused under the provisions of TEC 25.086. Students enrolled in prekindergarten and kindergarten shall also attend school. PARENTS WILL NEED TO FILL OUT A "HALF DAY PARENT REQUEST LEAVE FORM" IF CHECKING OUT THEIR STUDENTS BEFORE 3:25.

Ensure their child's compliance with school attendance requirements and promptly report and explain absences and tardies Mrs. Rodriguez in the front office at 219-8100.

Miller's Tardy Policy

****Students who are tardy 3 times and more will need to attend Academic Reinforcement Time and will not be able to attend extra recess time. Students will be required to make up the missed time for being tardy.

****Students who do not finish homework or classwork where ample time was given will attend Academic Reinforcement Time with Mr. Booe and will not be able to attend extra recess time. Students will be required to make up the missing academic work first before they go outside to play.
