For **FIRST TIME** students taking dual credit with South Plains College you must:

1. **SPC ADMISSIONS APPLICATION:** Apply online at <https://apply.southplainscollege.edu> (this needs to be done only once).
2. **DUAL CREDIT CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT FORM:** Complete and submit the SPC “Dual Credit Concurrent Enrollment” form. A copy of the concurrent enrollment form is provided in this packet or can be found online at www.southplainscollege.edu/dualcredit. Students can submit this form at the SPC Levelland campus or the Lubbock campus at 3907 Ave. Q.
3. **TRANSCRIPT:** SPC requires one copy of an unofficial high school transcript. You can request a copy of your high school transcript from the CHS registrar, Pam Beckett, in the main office. Once you have a copy, you must submit it with the dual credit concurrent enrollment form listed in step 2.
4. **TSI SCORES:** Provide to SPC proof of passing TSI scores or proof of meeting exemptions via ACT, SAT, PSAT or STAAR scores. See TSI Assessment Quick Reference in the next section for more information.
5. **REGISTRATION & PAYMENT:** Once all four steps above are completed, log in to “MySPC” account to register for course and submit payment by deadline (dates will be posted online for each semester).

For **RETURNING** dual credit students with South Plains College you must:

1. **DUAL CREDIT CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT FORM:** Complete and submit the SPC “Dual Credit Concurrent Enrollment” form. A copy of the concurrent enrollment form is provided in this packet or can be found online at www.southplainscollege.edu/dualcredit. Students can submit this form at the SPC Levelland campus or the Lubbock campus at 3907 Ave. Q. Check with your counselor to make sure you are still TSI compliant (must pass prior dual credit coursework).
2. **REGISTRATION & PAYMENT:** Log in to “MySPC” account to register for course and submit payment by deadline (dates will be posted online for each semester).

TSI Quick Reference

Texas Success Initiative (TSI) Scores for Compliance

- Math 350
- Reading 351
- Writing 340 MC + 4 Essay or Less than 340 MC + 4 Diagnostic Level + 5 Essay

**When testing for writing, students must take both the multiple choice and essay portions the first time. If students pass one of the two sections of the writing, they may retake the section they did not pass.*

TSI Exemptions

- **STAAR EOC:** Algebra II score 4000, English III score 4000
- **SAT:** (On or after March 5, 2016) 530 on mathematics and/or 480 evidenced based reading and writing (EBRW)
- **ACT:** Composite score of 23 with a 19 on the Math and/or 19 on English
(STAAR, SAT and ACT scores are valid for 5 years from date of test.)
- **Previous Dual Credit Coursework:** Students who have satisfactorily completed college-level coursework (as determined by the receiving institution). At SPC, this is a grade of C or better in a related college-level course.
- **PSAT/NMSQT:** (On or after October 15, 2015) 460 Evidenced Based Reading & Writing (EBRW) and 510 Mathematics
- **STAAR EOC Scores: (These scores can only be used for students' junior year enrollment in Dual Credit classes.)** These scores do NOT meet TSI for senior year, but students may be exempt in Math and/or Reading & Writing for the following year based on prior college coursework.
 - Algebra I 4000 & successfully completed Algebra II High School course
 - English II 4000

Other Info

- **Pre-Assessment Activity (PAA)** must be completed PRIOR to taking the TSI. The link for the PAA can be found on the testing page for SPC or on the testing page for Coronado High School. Print the completion certificate sent via email and take it to the testing location on the day you take the TSI.
- **Test at CHS:** Register for TSI online at the CHS testing information page. See CHS testing coordinator, Christy Loafman in room 107 or call 219-1142. TSI cost is \$15.00 (cash or check) for all parts and \$5.00 for re-test on each part. Available test dates are posted online.
 - **Testing also available at SPC and Texas Tech. Please see their websites for availability and fees.**
