

### **What is the TSIA2 Assessment?**

The TSIA2 Assessment is a placement test that helps determine whether you are ready for college-level courses or if you need support courses in the areas of English and Math. The TSIA2 is not a pass-or-fail test.

**Students will need an SPC Student ID to test! Students will receive their Student ID within 48 hours of completing the free South Plains College admission application [HERE](#).**

***Make sure you submit ALL three pages of your TSIA2 including your diagnostic scores!***

Are there any exemptions for taking the TSIA2?

Yes! There are a few TSIA2 Exemptions, but there are requirements that you must meet to receive these exemptions. You can view the full list of TSIA2 Exemptions [HERE](#).

### **COVID -19 Exemptions will continue through the summer of 2022!**

***For dual credit math courses:*** a student must have a high school GPA above 80, have successfully completed Algebra II at the high school level with a "C" or better, and have the approval of their high school counselor.

***For dual credit English courses:*** a student must have a high school GPA above 80, have successfully completed English II at the high school level with a "C" or better, and have the approval of their high school counselor.

***For 9th & 10th graders who have yet to complete Algebra II or English II:*** these students will still qualify for the TSIA2 exemption, that can be used for History, Geography or BCIS.

***For incoming 9th grade students:*** these students will qualify for the 2020-2021 TSIA2 exemption if they have a final 8th grade GPA of 80 or above.

*\*Please know that if an exempted dual credit student successfully completes a college-level course that is TSIA2 restricted with a letter grade of "C" or better, that student WILL become TSIA2 compliant in that subject area.*
