Welcome

Anna Jackson shared a video of activities, recognitions and programs in and around Lubbock I.S.D. Looking at 2018, members were encouraged to suggest items the administration should consider for the 2018-2019 school year.

Review / Vote on Exemptions of the Final District of Innovation Plan
