What is a SHAC?

A SHAC is a group of individuals representing segments of the community, appointed by the school district to serve at the district level, to provide advice to the district on coordinated school health programming and its impact on student health and learning. SHAC also provides an efficient, effective structure for recommending age-appropriate, sequential health education programs, and early intervention and prevention strategies that can easily be supported by local families and community stakeholders.

- SHAC addresses the health needs of students, helps meet district performance goals and alleviates financial constraints.
- SHAC plays an important role in communicating the connection between health and learning to school administrators, parents and community stakeholders.
- SHAC can help parents and community stakeholders reinforce the health knowledge and skills children need to make healthy choices for a lifetime.
