1. Mission & Vision:

- **Brown Elementary Mission and Vision:**
- **Mission:** The mission of Brown Elementary School is to provide a safe, positive learning environment that assures the academic and social development of each child. Together with parents and community, the Brown Elementary staff prepares each student to function effectively in an ever-changing technological world and uphold Lubbock ISD's Standards of Excellence.
- **Vision:** Brown Elementary will be a Met Standards Campus with 3 of 6 Distinctions. Every student, without exception and without excuse, will be proficient or advanced in reading, writing, math and science.

2. Funding:

- Title I funds of \$185,000
- We have added 2 full-time Instructional Coaches (Reading & Math) and 3 full-time Interventionist positions with our *campus* Title I funds.
- *Campus* Title I funds also provide professional development, supplies and materials for our teachers.

3. Schoolwide Program Plan

- **Brown Elementary** Campus Leadership Teams have developed a Campus Improvement Plan, which serves as our Title I Schoolwide program plan.
- Our Goals this year :
 - *Increase attendance of 97%, student achievement, and parental involvement.
 - *Increase the number of students obtaining Meets and Masters on STAAR Reading and Math
 - *Increase the number of families participating in the Brown PTA (membership)
 - *Increase Teachers identified through TIA (Teacher Incentive Allotment)
 - *Ensure teacher Professional development and Data Driven Instruction

4. Curriculum
