Credit must be earned by the end of the semester in which the student is enrolled in the course and may not be rolled over to summer school or the following semester. The recovered grade for an Edgenuity credit recovery course cannot exceed 75% and the grade and credit will become part of the student's permanent grade record and added to the official transcript by the counselor.</p>
